



Pet Partner Evaluations

- ❖ The handler should purchase the Delta Society Home Study Course (can be purchased online at www.deltasociety.org) or attend a Workshop given by a Delta Society Instructor. It is best to complete the course before you come to the evaluation – it will tell you exactly what you will need to do. Sunshine On A Leash does not offer the Workshop.
- ❖ A fee of \$25 must be pre-paid to secure a spot for the evaluation. This fee is non-refundable if the team does not attend the evaluation.
- ❖ Proof of vaccinations, including rabies and Bordetella. Please send a copy with your application or bring it to the evaluation.
- ❖ After you submit all the registration forms to Delta Society, they will send you an identification badge to be worn on your visits; two years of liability insurance is also included.
- ❖ You are now ready for visiting! Contact a *Sunshine On A Leash* coordinator who will help you get started if you want to visit as a *Sunshine On A Leash* member.

Pet Partner Health Requirements After You Pass The Evaluation

- ❖ An examination by a veterinarian is needed; who must complete the health screening forms in the registration packet.
- ❖ Vaccines need to be up-to-date, including Bordetella (which must be given every 6 months).
- ❖ A fecal exam is needed every 6 months.
- ❖ Dental work needs to be done if indicated on the exam.
- ❖ Any other medical problems found that relate to visiting should be noted. A copy of this notation should be sent to a *Sunshine On A Leash* coordinator to be kept on file.
